
As we respond to hearing God's Word and prepare to feast at God's table we contemplate the many ways we serve the Kingdom of God through our time, talents, and gifts.

that we should at all times and in all places give thanks and praise to you, almighty and merciful God, through our Savior Jesus Christ.


In the wonder and mystery of the Word made flesh
